



In consultation with their cosmetic surgeon, many patients are choosing to have a NON SURGICAL RHINOPLASTY. Its popularity has soared recently especially for those wanting an immediate aesthetic improvement as they may be currently unable to undergo surgery, are time poor or simply don't require more intensive surgery for a permanent result.

Injectable Rhinoplasty is virtually an 'in/out' two visit procedure that can correct any dip on the bridge of the nose, broaden a narrow one or correct imperfections after rhinoplasty surgery. The procedure is done in the doctors rooms and is virtually painless following the use of topical anaesthetic. The procedure is two fold. The initial visit will enable you to meet and discuss your concerns whilst also gaining an idea of the result and what is actually achievable. With the injection of 'quick look' saline solution into the areas you can see the potential result and decide whether you would like to go ahead with a more permanent filler no sooner than the next day. The trial solution lasts 30 minutes before its absorbed by your body. Beyond some minimal redness and swelling or the unlikely event of bruising there are no side effects. Photos are taken for you to see the before and after difference. Upon deciding to proceed an appointment is scheduled and the injectable procedure using permanent dermal fillers is performed.
